Memorial of 3-08-01 Discovery Court Order

- 1. This defendant has filed approximately 12 discovery motions on this case from July '00 through April '01.
- 2. Per Exhibit A the Court Ordered, on 9-13-00, "the Commonwealth to preserve all evidence held by the F.P.D. including all communications, photos and police notes related to the alleged underlying criminal incident."
- 3. The Court Order in #2, above, would include many of this defendant's discovery requests that the prosecutor and police refuse to produce to this defendant 10 months after the charges were filed causing this criminal case. The following requests in this defendant's "Omnibus Discovery Motion" are specifically included as catagories of evidence to be preserved by the 9-13-00 Court Order:
- a. Request #1 the 7-4-00 F.P.D. (Framingham Police Dept.)
 Booking Photos of Peter H. Gear and related booking information.

- b. Request #2 the 6 F.P.D./Sanchez photos taken of Gear on 7-5-00 alleging his injuries. In particular, the picture of **G**ear with the "big red bloody wound on his right forehead".
- c. Requests #'s 6 & 8 phone call information/evidence including certified copies of all turret tapes and phone call tapes, 911 computer print-outs, and related log and dispatch reports.
- d. Request #14 "Chain of Custody" of Mobil video tape.
- e. Request #16 All radio communications tapes and turret tapes.
- f. Requests #27, 28, 29 Police note evidence.
- 4. In addition, see Exhibits B and C which the F.P.D. and Middlesex District Attorney's Office confirm that they have 6 photos of the alleged victim in the case, Peter H. Gear. These are the same photos that boththe defendant's investigating attorney and defendant have viewed. Significant is the picture of Gear with a "big red bloody head wound" on his right forehead.

Memorial to the 3-08-01 Court Order Produce "Brady " Discovery

- 5. On 3-08-01 the Court, Judge Paul Healy, ordered the prosecution to produce the alleged victim's, Peter H. Gear's, medical/hospital records relating to his alleged injuries as claimed per the 6 "Sanchez photos", as above. Healy also ordered the prosecution to produce the F.P.D. booking photo and report made as a result of Gear's 7-4-00 arrest by the F.P.D.
- 6. This defendant was never given a <u>written</u> copy of that 3-08-01 order, as in #5.
- 7. There was compliance hearing scheduled for 4-4-01 to insure this defendant receives the Court ordered discovery in #5 and that hearing was concelled without this defendant being notified.

Please clarify by producing to this defendant the discovery he is required to receive via his discovery motions, motions to compel, and 3-08-01 Court Order.
