Bernard Weissman, 49 South Columbus Avenue,
Mount Vernon, New York, was interviewed on August 10, 1964,
at the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
360 East 49th Street, New York, New York.

Mr. Weissman advised that he had never been in the
Cassel area in Dallas, Texas, and also that he had never met
anybody of Officer J. D. Toubert.

He stated that during November, 1963, when he was
in Dallas, Texas, he was employed by Carpet Engineers,
Incorporated, 1002 South Beasley Street, in the Oak Cliff
section of Dallas, Texas. Mr. Weissman advised that he worked
from 8:00 p.m. to approximately twelve midnight and believed
he was working during the evening of November 14, 1963.

Mr. Weissman also stated that during his stay in
Dallas, Texas, he resided at 4018 Reiger Street with William
Harley. He stated that Harley presently resides at 2558 West
14th Avenue, Denver, Colorado.

Mr. Weissman consented to having his photograph
taken, copies of which have been forwarded to The President's
Commission.
