Bernard Weissman, 40 South Columbus Avenue, New York, New York, was interviewed on August 10, 1964, at the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, 35 West 49th Street, New York, New York.

Mr. Weissman advised that he had never been in the Council Fire in Dallas, Texas, and also that he had never met Lucy or Officer J. P. Tippit.

He stated that during November, 1963, when he was in Dallas, Texas, he was employed by Carpet Engineers, Incorporated, 1002 South Beale Street, in the Oak Cliff section of Dallas, Texas. Mr. Weissman advised that he worked from 8:00 p.m. to approximately twelve midnight and believed he was working during the evening of November 14, 1963.

Mr. Weissman also stated that during his stay in Dallas, Texas, he resided at 4618 Reiger Street with William Bailey. He stated that Bailey presently resides at 3553 West 11th Avenue, Denver, Colorado.

Mr. Weissman consented to having his photograph taken, copies of which have been forwarded to the President's Commission.
