- A. I think he walked right away and sat down, okay?
- Q. Okay. Did King, when he came over, say anything to you before you told him to go back and sit down?
  - A. (Witness shakes head negatively.)
  - Q. Nothing, as far as you can recall?
  - A. (Witness shakes head negatively.)
- Q. Did any other patron, whether it was Sawyer, DePasquale, Wyne, anybody, say anything to you or Elbery to knock it off? Did anybody else seem disturbed?
  - A. No.
  - Q. Okay.
- A. They were aware of it, I -- you know, I can't say. They were aware of it.
  - Q. Well, you told us this was a small bar?
  - A. Right.
- Q. So obviously hearing words exchanged doesn't take too much to hear that, right?
  - A. Right.
- Q. But the only person to come over and in effect confront the situation was Mr. King?
  - A. Right.
