Q. During the course of the struggle with Mr. Elbery on Shrewsbury Street, do you recall anything that he said during the course at that time?

Q. Now, sir, the two drinks that you had had at the Winner's Circle, did they affect your sobriety in any way?

Q. Did they affect your memory of that night's events?

A. No, sir.
