It has been determined that ELBERY had previously been issued a license to purchase firearms by the State of Massachusetts. The subsequent trace of the UZI pistol and the AK-47 rifle disclosed that ELBERY had previously purchased the firearm from a Federal firearms dealer. The remaining firearms are currently being traced by ATF at this time.

This memo is submitted in response to a request for Worcester Field Office investigative reports by Attorney Bradford N. Louison, 67 Batterymarch Street, Boston, Massachusetts, made on January 29, 1998.

As you are aware, Attorney Louison is representing the Town of Shrewsbury and its police officers in a law suit filed by Michael Elbery, pending in United States District Court, Boston, Massachusetts.

On February 2, 1998, Resident Agent in Charge Monty J. Monteiro advised Attorney Louison, via telephone, that request for assistance (investigation 63290-94-0023J) was initiated on or about August 5, 1994 regarding Shrewsbury, Massachusetts Police Department's recovery of a number of firearms allegedly owned/possessed by Mr. Elbery at the E-Z Mini Storage Facility, 864 Boston Turnpike Road, Shrewsbury, MA. The investigation disclosed that Mr. Elbery was a convicted felon who had purchased most of these firearms from Massachusetts FFL's prior to his July 1993 Assault to Maim conviction; that he received a 10 year suspended sentence for said conviction and this fact ultimately resulted in the States request to maintain jurisdiction in this matter.

Resident Agent in Charge Monteiro further advised that there were no fire related opening or closing investigative reports prepared by ATF during its preliminary investigation of the aforementioned fire.

In view of the above, Mr. Louison agreed to verbally withdraw his formal request for investigative reports.
