RIGHT TO USE THE TELEPHONE

General Laws, Ch. 276, Sec. 33A: The police official in charge of the station or other place having a telephone wherein the person is held in custody, shall permit the use of the telephone at the expense of the arrested person, for allowing the arrested person to communicate with his family or friends, or arrange for release on bail, or engage the services of an attorney. Any such person shall be informed forthwith upon his arrival at such station or place of detention, of his right to use the telephone, and such use shall be permitted within one hour thereafter.
