Dear Michael,

Sometimes your little epistles really get to me - so I'm writing back without even typing this one. I want the balance of my fee. Do you feel better now? I want the FIO card as soon as possible. I believe a motion to dismiss is not appropriate - look up a case I lost which disposes such a motion, Comm. v. Chay Giang. That's an STL case.

I have enclosed a copy of the old statute which required the Commonwealth to prove carrying "whoever carries on his person..." and a copy of the new statute which has been in place since 1990 which does not - "whoever knowingly has in his possession...".

I told you the new statute does not require the Commonwealth to prove carrying because it doesn't - please feel free to fire me and use the law clerk or Worcester attorney who are willing to tell you what you want to hear. You should have counsel that you trust. I will not take

offense if you determine that you no longer have trust in me.

Because of a request by the D.A.'s office your trial date will be rescheduled to April 3, 1995.

It is my understanding from the SJC's Clerk's Office that the Justices will next consider pending applications for further appellate review on the 27th and 28th of this month.
